Proposition K.I.D.S. (Keep Improving District Schools)

Shall the Board of Education of the Crystal City School District No. 47, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy of the District by \$0.8000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and reduce the debt service levy by \$0.8000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to provide funds for the betterment of school facilities including, without limitation: security and safety enhancements throughout the District; heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) improvements; technology upgrades; to complete other renovations, remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and to meet the additional operating needs of the District?

If this proposition is approved by the voters, it will result in no net increase to the total tax levy by the voters because of the corresponding reduction in the debt service fund levy. The adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.8000 from \$4.0573, currently, to \$4.8573 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2020 Tax Year and can be applied to the assessed valuation each year thereafter.

PROPOSITION P

Shall the Board of Education of the Consolidated School District No. 6 of Jefferson County, Missouri borrow money in the amount of \$40,000,000 for the purpose of paying costs of acquiring, constructing, renovating, furnishing and equipping new and existing school sites, buildings and related facilities, including, but not limited to, (1) safety and security improvements at all school buildings, (2) replacement of classrooms at Fox High School, (3) partial replacement of Meramec Heights Elementary School, (4) partial replacement of Antonia Elementary School, (5) science lab renovations to support the District's science curriculum, and (6) various improvements to HVAC systems, roofing, paving, lighting, flooring, playgrounds and kitchens, and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is anticipated to remain unchanged at the current levy of \$0.39 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

Proposition S**(Safety, Security, Students)**

Shall the Board of Education of the North St. Francois County R-1 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Thirteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$13,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete safety and security improvements; to repair and/or replace roofs; to increase energy efficiency through replacement of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to upgrade the music rooms and the auditorium; to address ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliance issues to increase accessibility; to replace kitchen equipment; to install new playground equipment; to resurface the existing track; to prepay the Series 2019 lease financing; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.2134 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
