Shall the Board of Education of the De Soto #73 School District, Missouri be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.1500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to provide additional funds to address safety and security initiatives within school facilities, and meet the associated operating expenses of the District?

(The District intends to reduce the debt service levy by \$0.1500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to offset the estimated \$0.1500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation increase to the operating levy and will result in no net increase to the total tax levy if this Proposition is approved by the voters. Approval of this proposition is estimated to increase the District's adjusted operating tax levy to \$3.5735 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and will be applied to the assessed valuation in tax year 2019 and each year thereafter.)

Shall the Board of Education of the Consolidated School District No. 6 of Jefferson County, Missouri borrow money in the amount of \$70,000,000 for the purpose of paying costs of acquiring, constructing, renovating, furnishing and equipping new and existing school sites, buildings and related facilities, including, but not limited to, (1) safety and security improvements at all school buildings, (2) construction of a new Antonia Elementary School to replace the existing school, (3) science lab renovations to support the District's science curriculum, (4) phase 1 replacement of classrooms at Fox High School, construction of a new library at Seckman Middle School and a student commons area at Seckman High School, and partial replacement of Meramec Heights Elementary School, and (5) various improvements to HVAC systems, roofing, paving, lighting, flooring, playgrounds and kitchens, and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to increase \$0.40 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property from \$0.39 to \$0.79 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

PROPOSITION SAFE STUDENTS

Shall the Board of Education of the Grandview R-11 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,750,000) for the purpose of increasing student safety and enhancing the learning environment District-wide by completing the following projects: building and furnishing additional classrooms at the high school; adding safety locks to all district classrooms; completing electrical upgrades at the elementary school; constructing and equipping a new middle school cafeteria; installing new heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) in the elementary gym; tuck-pointing; completing other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof?

(If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0795 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.)
