

NOTICE OF PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE MEETING

ANTIRE ROAD AT WILLIAMS CREEK ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PROJECT NO. STP-5460 (604)

Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that a public open house meeting to view the proposed improvements to Antire Road at the Williams Creek Road Intersection will be held at Jefferson County Library Northwest Branch at 5680 Missouri PP, High Ridge, MO 63049, on Wednesday, February 7th 2018, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Access is available for individuals requiring personal assistance. The purpose of this open house meeting is to introduce the proposed project and to show the enhancements and improvements to the intersection. Written statements will be received, and made part of the public meeting record if received within ten days after the date of the hearing. The presently contemplated improvements are as follows:

The county will be proposing a re-alignment of Antire Road at the intersection of Williams Creek Road. The profile and alignment of Antire will be changed to improve the sight distance for vehicles turning on and off of Williams Creek Road. Antire Road and Williams Creek Road roads will be re-constructed and shoulders will be added within the project limits. The total proposed length of the project is approximately 800 feet on Antire Road and 275 feet on Williams Creek Road. Roadway pavement surfaces will be asphaltic concrete. The purposes of this project are to address safety concerns and preserve the existing features of this roadway corridor.

Tentative schedules for right of way acquisition and construction can be discussed at the hearing.
