The authorization of the bonds will authorize the district to fix, establish, maintain and collect rates and charges for the services provided by the district through its waterworks system, including all extensions and improvements thereto hereafter constructed or acquired by the District, in addition to the other rates and charges for such services provided by law, as will produce income and revenues sufficient to provide funds to pay the costs of operation and maintenance of said waterworks system and the principal of and interest on said bonds as they become due and to retire the same within thirty-five years from the date thereof, and to provide for the establishment of reasonable reserves therefor.
