5 **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri, (hereafter, the “County”), in response to
6 a certain Invitation for Bid, received and opened bids for the construction of the East Rock
7 Creek Road Safety Improvements Program; and

8 **WHEREAS**, after reviewing the bids set forth above, the County determined that
9 it was in the best interests of the County to award the bid for the East Rock Creek Road
10 Safety Improvements Program to Pace Construction Company, LLC. upon approval by the
11 County Council and the County Executive; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinance 21-0561, Jefferson County, Missouri entered
13 into a Contract with Pace Construction Company, LLC. in the amount of two hundred
14 ninety-nine thousand, seven hundred seventy-seven dollars and zero cents (**\$299,777.00**),
15 subject to budgetary limitations, for the East Rock Creek Road Safety Improvements
16 Program; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council passed Ordinance 22-0280
18 on May 10, 2022, authorizing the County Executive to enter into Change Order Number 1

1 to the construction contract with Pace Construction Company, LLC for a decrease of nine
2 thousand, six hundred forty-three dollars and thirty cents (**\$9,643.30**) to the contract sum,
3 subject to budgetary limitations:

4 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County Council finds that it is now necessary and in the
5 best interest of the County to execute Change Order Number 2 for an increase of one
6 hundred thirty-five thousand, six hundred twenty-two dollars and sixty cents (**\$135,622.60**)
7 to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations with Pace Construction Company,
8 LLC. for the East Rock Creek Road Safety Improvements Program Contract.

5 **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri, (hereafter, the “County”), in response to
6 a certain Invitation for Bid, received and opened bids for the construction of the Seckman
7 Road Intersection and Pedestrian Improvements; and

8 **WHEREAS**, after reviewing the bids set forth above, the County determined that
9 it was in the best interests of the County to award the bid for the Seckman Road Intersection
10 and Pedestrian Improvements to Gershenson Construction Co. Inc., upon approval by the
11 County Council and the County Executive; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinance 21-0283, Jefferson County, Missouri entered
13 into a Contract with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc. in the amount of two million, five
14 hundred twelve thousand, two hundred twenty dollars and zero cents (**\$2,512,220.00**),
15 subject to budgetary limitations, for the Seckman Road Intersection and Pedestrian
16 Improvements STP-7202(620) & STP-5403(686); and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council passed Ordinance 21-0393
18 on August 23,2021 authorizing the County Executive to enter into Change Order Number

1 1 to the construction contract with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc. to increase some
2 quantities pay items and to add some pay items for work provided for in the contract, for
3 an increase of twenty-five thousand, five hundred eighteen dollars and twenty-six cents
4 **(\$25,518.26)** to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council passed Ordinance 21-0511
6 on November 22, 2021 authorizing the County Executive to enter into Change Order
7 Number 2 to the construction contract with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc. to increase
8 some quantities pay items and to add some pay items for work provided for in the contract,
9 for an increase of thirty-six thousand, eight hundred seven dollars and seventy cents
10 **(\$36,807.70)** to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council passed Ordinance 22-0272
12 on April 25, 2022 authorizing the County Executive to enter into Change Order Number 3
13 to the construction contract with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc. to increase some
14 quantities pay items and to add some pay items for work provided for in the contract, for
15 an increase of sixty-five thousand, one hundred ninety-four dollars and forty-nine cents
16 **(\$65,194.49)** to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council passed Ordinance 22-0380
18 on July 25, 2022 authorizing the County Executive to enter into Change Order Number 4
19 to the construction contract with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc. to increase some
20 quantities pay items and to add some pay items for work provided for in the contract, for
21 an increase of seventy thousand, four hundred ninety-seven dollars and forty-five cents
22 **(\$70,497.45)** to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works of Jefferson County, Missouri
2 requests the revision of Ordinance 22-0380, to adjust the amounts of Change Order
3 Number 4, due to an incorrect number of units entered on the “Bituminous Pavement
4 Mixture PG64-22 (Surface Leveling)” pay item for the Seckman Phase 2 project, resulting
5 in a decrease of seven thousand, three hundred sixty-two dollars and fifty cents (**\$7,362.50**)
6 to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations, with Gershenson Construction Co.
7 Inc. for the Seckman Road Intersection and Pedestrian Improvements Contract, STP-
8 7202(602) & STP-5403(686).

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, COUNCIL,**
10 **AS FOLLOWS:**

11 Section 1. Amendment of Change Order Number 4 for a decrease of seven
12 thousand, three hundred sixty-two dollars and fifty cents (**\$7,362.50**) to the contract sum
13 with Gershenson Construction Co. Inc., for the Seckman Road Intersection and Pedestrian
14 Improvements Contract STP-7202(602) & STP-5403(686), for a revised total contract cost
15 of two million, seven hundred two thousand, eight hundred seventy-five dollars and forty
16 cents (**2,702,875.40**) is approved, subject to budgetary limitations.

17 Section 2. The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council authorizes the County
18 Executive to execute an Amendment to Change Order Number 4 on behalf of Jefferson
19 County. A copy of said Change Order is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated
20 by reference.
