1 **AN ORDINANCE RENEWING THE BID AWARDS FOR CERTAIN**

1 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works of Jefferson County, Missouri,
2 requested renewal from the awarded bidders, Collins & Hermann, Inc. and D & S Fencing
3 Co. to renew the contracts for the Revised Rebid Guardrail, Post & Accessories 2017 with
4 the County; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works of Jefferson County, Missouri, finds
6 it is in the best interest of the County to renew the bid award for the Revised Rebid
7 Guardrail, Post & Accessories 2017 for the term of 10-23-19 to 10-22-21 with Collins &

12 of records as promulgated by the Secretary of State.

14 date of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity
15 shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.



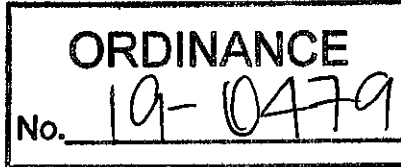

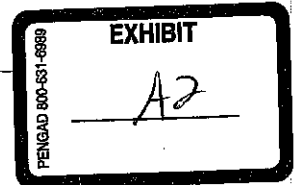
